

Hello Breckenridge Hunky Dory Half Marathon Trail Run Racers:

Thanks to all of the individuals who are currently signed up for the 2016 Breckenridge Hunky Dory Half Marathon. We are excited for another great race this year with the hopes of great weather as well. We are currently taking additional registrations for the race. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to register for the Hunky Dory Half Marathon. This email includes race details for the Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup> race taking place in beautiful Breckenridge, Colorado.

**Below are the details for the 2016 Breckenridge Hunky Dory Half Marathon Trail Run:**

- 1. Race will begin at 8:30 am sharp on August 6<sup>th</sup> at the intersection of Wellington Street & Reiling Road in Breckenridge (Little Red Schoolhouse). All racers will go off at once, regardless of ability. If you are racing competitively, please make your way to the front of the race crowd.**
- 2. Bib, goodie bag & race shirt pickup will begin at 7am in Vista Point Park (Little Red Schoolhouse). Race shirt sizes are on a first come, first serve basis.**
- 3. Race Course Map: The course map for the Hunky Dory Half Marathon is attached with this email. The race course is close to 13.1 miles, however, is not exact. Please note, if you have not made it to the 2<sup>nd</sup> aid station (around mile 6) by 11am, you will be asked to turn and head back towards the finish.**
- 4. Bib Placement: This is a chip-timed race, so bibs need to be placed around the stomach or chest area for optimal timing results. Please be diligent in placing your bib so it is visible for the timers and easily read by the chip timing system. We are using reusable cloth bibs for this year's race and will be collected at the end of the race as we use the same bibs for our Summer Trail Running Series.**
- 5. Race Results & Prizes: There will be different age race divisions for this race. The top three male and female racers will receive a plaque and gift card. Also, our top male and female racer in each of those age divisions will receive a prize. ALL RUNNERS WILL RECEIVE A PARTICIPATION MEDAL! Results will be posted online at [www.breckenridgerecreation.com](http://www.breckenridgerecreation.com) by Monday August 8<sup>th</sup>. Results will also be emailed out to participants on Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup>. Results are final 24 hours after the results have been posted.**
- 6. Parking: Parking will be limited in most areas. There is very little parking at the Little Red Schoolhouse parking lot. The best option is to carpool and be dropped off for the race. Other parking suggestions include the Satellite Parking Lot near the start/finish line, look for parking signage.**
- 7. Driving Directions: Driving Directions From South of Breckenridge: From Hyw 9, head North on Main Street. Take a right and head East on Wellington Street. Street comes to a three way stop, look for tents in Vista Point Park. Driving Directions From North of Breckenridge: From Hyw 9, head South on Main Street. Take a left and head East on Wellington Street. Street comes to a three way stop, look for tents in Vista Point Park.**
- 8. Water, Lunch & Aid Stations: There will be 4 aid stations along the race route, one you will pass by twice. Each aid station will have water, cups, gummies and a volunteer with a first aid kit in case of injuries for the runners. After the race, each runner is entitled to a free lunch where pizza and sub sandwiches will be provided. There will not be an awards ceremony, winners will be given their plaques or gifts as they pass the finish line.**
