The Recreation Center closed for renovations and annual maintenance September 5-24, with an additional pool closure through October 16.

A second mini-closure October 28-31 allowed the renovated lobby to open while construction continued through the rest of the building.

The new fitness wing opened just before the holidays and was introduced to the public at the "Debut for You" Open House on January 12.

The Breckenridge Tennis Center opened February 1 with an official ribbon cutting with the Breckenridge Town Council and members of the tennis community.



Stephen C. West Ice Arena

In October, the Ice Arena hosted 12 teams for the annual Kingdom Kup midget hockey tournament. The tournament was also expanded to include Peewee teams.

The Rocky Mountain Junior Hockey League's Breckenridge Bolts will play their 2017-2018 season at the Ice Arena, October to February.

The Division 1 Colorado College Tigers hockey team held an exhibition game on September 30, and hosted a Skate with the Tigers event prior to the game.





Gold Run Nordic Center

Gold Run early bird season passes went on sale September 1. The special pricing ended November 12. For the first time, Gold Run offered a fat biking season pass for \$150.

Gold Run held it's Open House and gear sale December 2-3, though trails didn't open until December 12.

A county-wide agreement completed in February links Gold Run with Frisco Nordic Center via a groomed recreation path. The path allows for skiing, snowshoeing and fat biking.

Gold Run is again hosting 14 total New Moon and Full Moon snowshoe tours and New Moon Fat Bike Tours between December to March.

Recreation Programs

The Programs division added new after school programs to kick off the 2017-2018 school year, including flag football, hiking and mountain biking.

The holiday ice skating show was held on December 8 at the Ice Arena featuring performances from 24 local skaters.

Rocky Mountain Guides partnered with Programs to offer backcountry programs, including Snow Talks, Companion Rescue Clinics, Backcountry Basics and Guided Ski Tours. The programs run December to April.

The Breckenridge Ascent Series returned in January with a reduced schedule of 4 races at Breckenridge Ski Resort.
