

ATTENTION ALL SKATEPARK USERS

- The Breckenridge Skatepark is an unsupervised facility. Skateboarding, free style BMX riding, Rollerblading, and use of scooters can be HAZARDOUS ACTIVITIES than can result in SERIOUS INJURY or DEATH. Use of this skatepark is at the sole risk of the user.
- Helmets, elbow and knee pads, and protective clothing are strongly recommended
- Skatepark is open from dawn to dusk
- Use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs are prohibited within the skatepark
- No glass containers are allowed within the skatepark
- This is a SHARED PUBLIC SPACE. BMX riders are allowed to use the park provided that bikes do not have metal pegs. Only plastic pegs may be used within the skatepark.
- Bikers should understand that not everyone thinks your use of this park is a good idea. Please help demonstrate that bikes are not a detriment to skateboarders or skateparks.
- If you see someone acting inappropriately, please be a mentor and share tips on skatepark etiquette
- ABSOLUTELY NO METAL SHOVELS or other metal equipment may be used to remove snow. This will permanently damage the skatepark and cause closures.
- Any person violating these rules, or other Town Ordinances or State laws may be temporarily or permanently banned from use of the skatepark. Littering, graffiti, and acts of vandalism will be prosecuted to the extent of the law, and YOU ARE ON CAMERA!
- No skis or snowboards
